

UFO Over Tenri, Nara Pref. Japan

Shrines and Ruins of NARA.

A member of the Television crew asked Mr. ARAI the curator of the UFO Library in TOKYO . If there was a UFO specialist in NARA. Mr. ARAI introduced them to Mr. AMAMIYA who supplied some film of UFO sightings and of witnesses to be added to their program.

The film crew then filmed some "MAN on THE STREET" interviews in front of NARA station asking the question "Have you ever seen a UFO?" They found three people who had witnessed UFO's around Mt. WAKAKUSA in NARA city also the television crew got information that AMAMIYA's Family (3 people; Father, mother, and daughter) have some UFO films and have many times experienced Sightings

Mr. AMAMIYA told reporters "I saw my first UFO 36 years ago and I've been watching ever since. I also published my book about UFO's at my own expense.

The members of NARA Television and some reporters tried to observe UFO's on the wide road of a Farm near MR.AMAMIYA's house on MAY 19th 1994.

It was a clear and very windy day. THE crew filmed MRS. AMAMIYA showing twenty-six pictures of a UFO she had taken with stop-action photography. These pictures show a UFO spinning and also changing it's shape and colour.

MR. AMAMIYA explained how to use various tools of his own creation which are used in the determinations of height, speed , angle, etc. of UFO's.

The western sky turned orange as evening neared. The crew filmed an Airplane and Its shadow to use as a comparison with a UFO since the two are often confused.

It was around 6:30 P.M.
MRS. AMAMIYA (named YUKI) found something in the northern sky. It was black and thin and long and was spinning perpendicularly. It flew very high overhead and moved toward the Southern sky. MR.AMAMIYA took both still photos and video of the object. Unfortunately, during the very brief encounter he could not achieve precise focus.
