### Some chosen cases:

On 11 April 1079 – in that day the Kingdom of Poland survived the worse crisis connecting with a conflict between the bishop **Stanislav of Szczepanowo**, who had been sentenced to death by King **Boleslav II the Generous** (aka **Efferus, Brave**) for a treason and killed on that day. According to an old chronicle: *Skies opened themselves above Cracow capital town and four eagles with a great ball came down. The bishop's body was restored to one piece again, which people recognized as a miracle. People saw strange things and lights in the sky on that day...*[5]

In 1499, in the Capricorn constellations... *a terrible and horrible Comet appeared itself at the end of the year. It was a reason of the many Important Persons' death after that event...* This information was marked in the Szczecin town chronicles. By the way, in Summer of that year the first crop circles were

described in the old English and Dutch chronicles. [1]

On 22 June 1577 in Krakow (Cracow) **Pawel Czarny of Olkusz**' daughter was *abducted during a very heavy thunder and hail storm. She was back on 30 June also during the terrible hail storm. She was interrogated by a special inquisition and her relation was published in a special bulletin.* Unfortunately, no one of them has not come to the present day. But we have some polemic papers, which say about that CE4. [1]

In 1610, above the Skoczow town appeared a “comet” surrounded by 17 lesser “stars” in the daylight! Very similar event took its place in 1620, when above Skoczow appeared three little blood-red suns in a ring. And in 1644 there were visible three little comets – they all were seen in the broad daylight! All those incident were mentioned in the local chronicle by **Jan Tilgner**. The next similar event occurred also in 1664. [1]

On 8 July 1618, there occurred more interesting incident nearby Szczecin. A **Klaus Neuman** watched a *strange light in the night sky. Suddenly he noticed something pigeon shaped thing, which landed near him and was converting itself into the 4-years-old boy in a white dress, who spoke to him. The “boy” disappeared in a few minutes and Neuman noticed a starlike object hovering above him, despite the fact that the sky had been covered with thick clouds all day long and the all stares could not be visible.* [1]

On 6 August 1662, the strange thing took its place over the Tatras Mts. According to old Slovakian chronicles, *there was seen a strange, fiery object, which hit a top of the Mt. Slavkosky Stit (Slovakia) and smashed it into pieces. The object – very similar to a dragon – came from the Polish side of the Tatras and landed near the Hochwald village (now Strba, Slovakia).* Famous Slovakian ufologist and writer **Dr. Milos Jesensky Ph.D.** found a traces of that event in old documents, however they were copies – the original documents had been stolen or dispersed on another museums many years ago. Now we think that that object could be either a meteor or a remain killer-satellite after the Atomic War of the Gods-Astronauts from behind 12,000 years. Dr. Jesensky described those theories in his book entitled *Bohove atomowych valek (Gods of the Nuke Wars)*, Usti nad Labem 1998. [3]

A day before the famous Tunguska Blast, on 29 June 1908, near the Zalesie village a strange phenomenon took its place. *I and three others were going to Zalesie... I don't remain an hour of that event but it was in the evening. Two hours after the sunset. Suddenly we notices a bright light in the cloudless sky. It was a meteor, which went from S-SW towards N-NE direction. Its speed was relatively smaller than a velocity of the ordinary shooting stars. The object made a distance circa 1/3 of the visible skies and vanished.* According to astronomers, that object had not anything common with famous Tunguska Meteorite, which fell down on 30 June 1908 at 07h17m11s of the Siberian time – 00h17m11s GMT. [1]

On 23 January 1913, some Nowy Targ and Ochotnica Gorna inhabitants saw o strange object, which crossed the sky, at 22:30 hrs. It was very bright and shone with white light. It was visible only 1 second. In a short time, the witnesses heart something like a thunder from a direction, where the “meteor” had

disappeared. The phenomenon was seen also in the Nowy Targ town. Nobody gave an explanation of that. [3]

In Summer 1914, a group of children played on a meadow in the Blachownia village near the Czestochowa town. Suddenly they noticed a strange light above nearby forest. It was firstly purple in its color but next it converted itself into the blue-violet glow. Small object was emerging from that glow and fell into bushes growing 500 meters far from children. They went to seek that “thing” immediately. They found a piece of the shining with green light jelly, which vanished in a short time. Now we think that they found a piece of so called “Angel’s hair” or “powder”. [1]

In the Summer 1922, the strange CE2 had its place in Warsaw. *I was going for the walk with my aunt and brother-in-law in the Targowek quarter. Suddenly we noticed something odd, which had been fallen from the skies. Firstly we were sure that that “thing” hit the soil but it was hovering 2-3 meters above a ground. It was a very big ball, very similar to two bowls fitted with edges to each other. It looked like made of aluminum. We stayed 100-150 meters from that strange structure. [...] Suddenly the UFO took-off and broke the sound barrier in a few seconds – in 1922!!! Finally the UFO disappeared in the NW part of the sky. It looked like blindly bright ball. That event was witnessed by hundreds of people. [...] Next we looked at the terrain, where the UFO had hovered above. The soil was dry and grass was burned.* – one of the eyewitnesses said. [1]

In September 1926 the strange event took place in a circumstances of the Ujazd village. In the afternoon time, between 15:00 and 17:00 hrs, 12-years old girl fed cows on the meadow. Suddenly she noticed three flying disc with one EBE inside. They hovered in the air 150-200 meters far from her and her cows. She got fright and decided to escape. She brought her cows and left the scene. The girl said that strange EBEs watched her circa about 5 minutes. The Aliens were relatively short, they were 1 – 1.2 meter long. They wore dark-green one-piece-suits. She has not remembered any special features of their signalments. [1]

In the Summer 1938, in the Czernica village many local inhabitants saw the fiery ball, which fell down from the sky. Peasants followed it and they found a strange disc-shaped structure on a meadow. The legend says that that flying disc was transported to the SS-troops barracks in Jelenia Gora and there it was later examined by three German scientists: **Prof. Max von Laue**, **Prof. Werner Heisenberg** and **Prof. Otto Hahn**. They decided to deliver the mysterious disc to Berlin, where it was researched by the SS-experts and scientists. They made several models of the Nazi-German flying discs *Haunebu* or *Vril* aka *Foo-fighters*... Dr. Jesensky and me researched that story and we came to a conclusion that it is not true in 75%. [2 and 4]

In a night before World War Two in Europe, on 31 August 1939, many inhabitants of the little village of Spytkowice saw a great, shining and fiery cross on a top of the mountain called Mt. Golgota. They were sure that it is a sign of the close war. In fact, it was. The first German and Slovakian troops invaded Poland at 04:45 hrs in the next day and Spytkowice, Wysoka and Jordanow became to be a scene of the first battle of that war. Here was another UFO-wave in the mid 1990’s, when people watched strange

light-phenomena on Mt. Golgota there. They were investigated by **Mr. Bronislaw Rzepecki** and me. [3]

On 17 September 1939, at 17:00 hrs, near Sochaczew 4 persons witnessed 7 German bomber planes, which literally stood into the air. After a couple of minutes the planes became to be clouds of dark smoke and vanished. The same phenomenon was witnessed by local peasants, who saw 9 German planes, which had been destroyed by strange plane two days later. Was it the UFO-intervention or the Polish secret AA-weapon??? [1]

During WW2 was also strange event in a small village of Nowiny. It occurred in May 1943. 5 witnesses saw a UFO, which had landed 100 meters far from them. They watched also 8 or 9 EBEs 1.5 m tall. The Aliens wore one-piece-suits, which were green in their color. Aliens invited them with hands gesture inside Their craft but they did not come closer. They went inside the UFO and it took-off. The CE lasted one hour. [1]

And another case from time of the WW2. It took its place in Gdynia – Babie Doly shortly after 14 July 1943. Prisoner of the concentration camp – a Frenchmen named **S. Theau** (nickname) went back to the camp on a sea-shore. Suddenly he noticed a strange thing in a slope of the sand dune. It was something like a thick disc wit a dome on its upper part. There was a woman inside it. She ordered him to help her. She was very similar to famous Nazi test-pilot **Capt. Hanne Reitsch!** He helped her to dig up the craft. She get in it and the craft took-off. I must add that there was the Institute of the Torpedo- and U-boat Weapon Researches Gotenhafen-Hexelgrund belonging to the Nazi-German Kriegsmarine (Navy) and the rocket test range Grossendorf belonging to the SS. Then it is possible that the flying saucer seen by S. Theau was a prototype of the *Haunebu* or *Vril* construction... [2]

The UFOs were seen also during the Warsaw's Rise in August 1944. One witness watched the German bomber-plane, which was chased by several *Foo-fighters*. They looked like lenses and followed the plane in a V formation. The witness thought that it was a demonstration of the new German weapon. [1]

During the WW2 also a series of strange events took its place in the Kuznica village, in Autumn 1944. Many inhabitants of that village observed a strange UFO-landing or better crash-landing, which occurred there. A spherical "thing" fell from the sky and made crated 40 meters in its diameter. German soldiers came to the place of crash and brought the all debris and remains in unknown direction. Local peasants thought that it had been a test of the Hitler's miraculous weapon – the *Wunderwaffe*... But nobody knows the real truth about that. The crater exists to the present day. The case was investigated by Mr. Bronislaw Rzepecki. [4]

In the mid June 1945 the UFO crashed near the Ustka port. According to a legend, the UFO was piloted by two EBEs. The all debris and Aliens' corpses were gathered by Russian soldiers and brought to the Soviet Air Force base in Borne Sulinowo. But we have nothing more than a relation by one eyewitness. [4]

And at the end I'd like to mention one relation from Russia, which we got it from a soldier of the Soviet occupation forces in Poland. It occurred in the Swinoujscie harbor, in the Spring 1947. The witness was staying on a post on the beach, when he noticed a formation of the flying discs, which came from the open sea. He tried to attack with his bayonet one of the disc, which passed by him on a distance of 2 meters from him! Later the C-in-C of the unit said that they had been German's flying machines from the *Graf Zeppelin* carrier, which was sunk in the sea. (In fact the aircraft carrier *Graf Zeppelin* was sunken in Szczecin)

After that incident he and other eyewitnesses had to sign a statement that the all incident would be kept in a secret. Next he was moved to Pilawa (now Baltijsk)... [6]
